CS Fab respects your privacy and is committed to protecting your personal data. This Privacy Policy explains how CS Fab collects, uses and protects personal information when you visit our website or contact us about our services.

****1. Who we are****

CS Fab is a stainless steel fabrication and pipework business based in Ireland.

For the purposes of applicable data protection legislation, including the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), CS Fab is the data controller of personal information collected through this website and through direct communications with us.

****2. What personal information we collect****

When you contact CS Fab through our website, email, telephone or other communication channels, we may collect information such as:

- Your name
- Company or business name
- Email address
- Telephone number
- Information contained in your enquiry or message
- Information required to prepare quotations or provide our services
- Any other information you voluntarily provide to us

We aim to collect only information that is reasonably necessary for the relevant purpose.

****3. How we collect your information****

We may collect personal information when you:

- Submit an enquiry through our website contact form
- Contact us by email or telephone
- Request a quotation
- Enquire about our fabrication, pipework or welding services

- Become a customer of CS Fab
- Communicate with us regarding work that we are carrying out or have carried out

****4. How we use your personal information****

We may use your personal information to:

- Respond to enquiries
- Contact you regarding your enquiry
- Prepare quotations and estimates
- Provide and manage our services
- Arrange work and communicate with customers
- Maintain business and customer records
- Issue invoices and manage payments
- Meet legal, accounting and regulatory obligations
- Protect the security of our website, systems and business

We will not use your personal information for purposes that are incompatible with the reason it was originally collected unless permitted or required by law.

****5. Legal basis for processing****

Depending on the circumstances, CS Fab may process personal data because:

- It is necessary to respond to your request or take steps at your request before entering into a contract
- It is necessary to perform a contract or provide services to you
- We have a legitimate business interest in operating and managing our business
- We are required to process information to comply with a legal obligation
- You have provided consent where consent is required

****6. Website contact forms****

If you use a contact form on our website, the information you provide may be processed by our website provider, Webador, in order to deliver the form submission to CS Fab.

The information may also be sent to our business email address so that we can respond to your enquiry.

We will only request information that is reasonably necessary to deal with your enquiry.

****7. Sharing your information****

We do not sell or rent your personal information.

Where necessary to operate our business, personal information may be processed by service providers working on our behalf, such as website, email, IT, accounting or other business service providers.

We may also disclose information where we are legally required to do so or where disclosure is necessary to protect our legal rights or comply with a lawful request.

****8. Website provider****

Our website is hosted and operated using Webador.

Webador may process certain information on behalf of website operators in connection with providing its website services. Webador provides information about its own privacy practices and the processing carried out through its platform in its Privacy Statement.

****9. Cookies and similar technologies****

Our website may use cookies or similar technologies.

Some cookies may be strictly necessary for the website to function. Other cookies, such as analytics, advertising or tracking cookies, may require your consent under applicable Irish and EU rules.

Where consent is required, you will be given appropriate information and the opportunity to provide or withdraw your consent.

The Data Protection Commission states that consent is normally required for non-essential cookies and tracking technologies, while strictly necessary cookies may be exempt. ****11. How long we keep personal information****

We keep personal information only for as long as reasonably necessary for the purpose for which it was collected.

Some business and financial records may need to be retained for longer periods where required by Irish law, taxation or accounting requirements.

Enquiry information that is no longer required will be deleted or securely disposed of where appropriate.

****12. Keeping your information secure****

CS Fab takes reasonable technical and organisational measures to protect personal information against unauthorised access, loss, misuse, alteration or disclosure.

However, no method of transmitting or storing information electronically can be guaranteed to be completely secure.

****13. Your data protection rights****

Subject to applicable legal conditions and exemptions, you may have rights under the GDPR including:

- The right to access your personal data
- The right to have inaccurate information corrected
- The right to request deletion of your personal data
- The right to request restriction of processing
- The right to object to certain processing
- The right to data portability in applicable circumstances
- The right to withdraw consent where processing is based on consent
